

(20.8) What is the fate of the gas released into the turbine condensers during regeneration of the charcoal absorbers in Fig. 20.6?

Answer: It is sucked into the ejectors again and recirculated back to the recombiners and then into the first decay tank. Then the sequence repeats itself. First recycle leads to a doubling of the decay-time, second recycle to trebling of the decay time, etc.
